Return of Land Deed for Roadway in Knox Scout Reservation

Director Seymour said that a letter had been received from Georgia – Carolina Council, Boy Scouts of America, requesting that the county return two parcels of land to the Georgia – Carolina Council.

Director Seymour said these parcels are on Fred R. Prater Parkway. He said that because of the easy access to the privately owned land at the Knox Scout Reservation by the general public from the parcels granted by the right of way deed, they had been having some trouble with vandalism, littering, etc.

Director Seymour said that the boat ramp belongs to the boy scouts.

Following some discussion, the committee agreed that the county should give the parcels back to the boy scouts.
